
Toggling In/Out Standard and Hyperkeys Modes	
Standard Mode	Hyperkeys Mode
(default)	 <p>Click the Hyperkeys button (or press Alt Z) to toggle in and out hyperkeys mode.</p>

Standard Mode	Hyperkeys Mode
(standard keyboard functions)	<p>N (to "insert" text) Enter (return to hyperkeys)</p>

Move Cursor by:	Standard Mode	Hyperkeys Mode
word	⬅ (left) / ➡ (right)	J (left) / L (right)
line	⬆ (up) / ⬇ (down) home (beginning) / end (end)	I (up) / K (down) [(beginning) /] (end)
character	Ctrl ⬅ (left) / Ctrl ➡ (right)	Shift J (left) / Shift L (right)
sentence	Alt B (previous) / Alt F (next)	Shift+I (previous) / Shift+K (next)

entire line	Ctrl Y	(same as standard)
to end of paragraph	Shift Alt Y	(same as standard)
shave off word (from end)	(N/A)	S (previous) / Shift S (current)
shave off word (from beginning)	(N/A)	Shift D (current)

Punctuation		
<i>Function</i>	<i>Standard Mode</i>	<i>Hyperkeys Mode</i>
insert punctuation/ toggle punctuation (automatically adjusts spacing and letter casing)	Place cursor at beginning of word following punctuation insertion point and press punctuation key. Instead of deleting and retyping to change punctuation, you can toggle among different punctuation marks by simply pressing the other punctuation keys.	(same as standard)
period (.) at end of sentence	Alt P	P
question mark (?) at end of sentence	Alt Q	Q
double-dash (--) at end of sentence	Alt D	=
butting in: interrupting with double-dashes (--) (for continuation from previous sentence within current paragraph style)	(N/A)	Shift B

cap letter	F6 (cap/uncap toggle)	A
cap word	highlight text, Shift F6	Shift A

insert and toggle 's, s, and s'	Alt A	press the accent symbol (`) key located on same key as the tilde (~) symbol
prefix/suffix	Ctrl K	W

<i>Function</i>	<i>Keyboard Shortcut</i>
THE WITNESS	F2, then 0 (number zero, not letter)
SPEAKER 1, SPEAKER 2, SPEAKER 3, etc.	F2, then 1, 2, 3, etc.

Transferring Text or Other Content From/To Files		
<i>Function</i>	<i>Standard Mode</i>	<i>Hyperkeys Mode</i>
read into current file all contents from another file	Alt R, then choose other file to insert	(same as standard)
write out any highlighted portion of content from current file into a separate file	Alt W, then name and save as new file (includes synced audio)	(same as standard)
